Not only our pension system is under attack, but also our social security system. This threatens to worsen the services provided by our healthcare system. In addition, employers are calling for an ever-increasing crackdown on sick people and demanding the introduction of waiting days for sick employees!

## **Our fundamental rights are being challenged!**

A ban on begging, expulsion from public spaces, questioning the right to demonstrate, increasingly repressive migration policies: an authoritarian shift, even in Luxembourg, which threatens our open and democratic society!

## **Our livelihood is under threat!**

A housing crisis that threatens the livelihoods of thousands of people and an ecological and climatic emergency that threatens our living conditions and primarily affects the most vulnerable have been relegated to the sidelines. The government prefers to attack the rights and achievements of those who are working to move the country forward.
