We have reached a critical point: while the world as we know it is faltering, the Luxembourg government and employers are launching a frontal attack on our social model and our achievements.

## On the streets now – For your future and that of your children!

#### Your pensions are at risk!

During his State of the Nation address, the Prime Minister made it clear that he wants to massively undermine our public and solidarity-based pension system, primarily by increasing the effective retirement age. No improvements are planned, meaning a 13% reduction in pension levels on average by 2052 and that the private insurance will be promoted at the expense of public finances and the general pension system.

## No more private life or family life!

Generalisation of Sunday working, liberalisation of shop opening hours, introduction of annual working hours, questioning of rest periods... The list of changes is long. Not to mention the weakening of our collective agreements, which would leave us completely at the mercy of our employers.

## Your fundamental rights are being challenged!

The weakest in society are being targeted, with a ban on begging, expulsion from public spaces, the right to demonstrate being challenged, increasingly repressive migration policies: this is a shift towards authoritarianism, also in Luxembourg, which puts our open and democratic society at risk!

## Your wages are under attack!

By attacking the collective bargaining rights of trade unions, the government and employers are trying to destroy our social model and are seriously jeopardising our salary conditions!

## Your purchasing power is suffering!

With its unilateral decision to abolish the energy price cap, the government has deliberately allowed energy prices to skyrocket, with increases of over 30% in some cases. As if housing prices weren't bad enough, energy costs are now also putting a strain on our purchasing power.

## Your social security could be dismantled!

It is not just our pension system which is under attack: our social security system is also in danger. The services provided by our healthcare system are likely to worsen. In addition, employers are calling for an ever-increasing crackdown on workers who are sick and demanding the introduction of (unpaid) days for sick employees!

## Your livelihood is under threat!

Crucial issues such as a housing crisis that threatens the livelihoods of thousands of people, and an ecological and climate emergency that threatens our living conditions and primarily affects the most vulnerable, have been relegated to the sidelines. Instead, the government has chosen to attack the rights and achievements of those who are working to move the country forward.
